Thank you for continuing to consult with the New York State Historic Preservation Office (SHPO). We have reviewed the submitted materials in accordance with the New York State Historic Preservation Act of 1980 (section 14.09 of the New York Parks, Recreation and Historic Preservation Law). These comments are those of the Division for Historic Preservation and relate only to Historic/Cultural resources.

We have reviewed your submission for the Maplewood Village Subdivision project. We note that the proposed project is located on land associated with the estate of the Former Selesian Rectory and School. We understand that the proposed project will include construction of a 68-lot residential subdivision 66 acres of which will be conservation easement area.

Based on this review, it is the opinion of OPRHP that the proposed project will have No Adverse Impact to the historic former Selesian Rectory and School property.

With regards to archaeological resources, OPRHP has reviewed *Phase 1 Cultural Resource Survey of the Proposed Maplewood Village at Goshen, Town of Goshen, Orange County, New York* (BTK Associates, July 2007). A comparison of the areas examined by the 2007 survey (Figure 17) and the current proposed development, as shown on Figure II-2 of the DEIS, indicates that the earlier investigation encompassed all areas of proposed disturbance in the current development. Based on the results of the 2007 investigation, we have no further archaeological concerns regarding this project. Should the project design be changed, we recommend further consultation with this office.
